TODAY'S MUSIC ARRANGER

Jim Swearingen - is starting his 50th year as a member of the arranging staff for The Ohio State University Marching Band. He has earned music education degrees from Bowling Green State University and The Ohio State University. Prior to his appointment at Capital University in 1987, he spent eighteen years teaching instrumental music in central Ohio. In recognition of distinguished contributions, Professor Swearingen was recently accorded the title of professor emeritus from Capital University. School directors, student performers and audiences worldwide have enthusiastically received his numerous contributions for band. With over 600 published works, he is one of the most prolific composers and arrangers of concert and marching band music today. In April 2015, the Ohio State School of Music honored Swearingen with its distinguished Alumnus Award.
