#### **TODAY'S MUSIC ARRANGER**

Michael Klesch is an arranger, program consultant and clinician for numerous marching bands across the country. In addition to being musical director and brass arranger for the Carolina Crown Drum and Bugle Corps, he is the wind arranger for the Calgary Stampede Show Band, and wind arranger for the University of Alabama Million Dollar Band and the University of Massachusetts Minuteman Marching Band. Michael was the wind arranger for the Bands of America Honor Band at the 2005, 2009, 2013 and 2017 Tournament of Roses Parade. He was a performer with the Garfield Cadets and finished out his time there as drum major of the 1983 DCI World Champions. Michael has served as an arranger and consultant with the Garfield Cadets, Spirit of Atlanta, Troopers, Colts, Crossmen, Phantom Regiment, Arizona Academy, and was inducted into the Drum Corps International Hall of Fame in the summer of 2012. This show is his third for The Ohio State University Marching Band.
